75. Put the Child First

Lt. Sheila Mercer, Regimental Put the Child First Director, would like to once again send these very important reminders to Company Commanders and Company Chaplains:

- 1. When a youth member either first joins The CLB or a member advances to the next section, they are required to complete the personal safety badge for that section.
- 2. Adult leaders cannot be approved as members of the CLB without first completing an adult training session of PTCF.

- 3. Officers who have not completed the current training year's session of PTCF must be paired with another officer who has completed this training when working with youth.
- 4. Officer promotions cannot be approved if the officer has not completed an adult PTCF training session for the current training year.
- 5. Once a session of PTCF has been completed by either adults or youth, please submit the standard record forms to CLB Records Officer, Maj. Ron Coish, ASAP.

77. GST / HST Rebate - Change for 2015 and Future Years

The CLB qualifies for a 50% rebate on GST / HST paid on invoices, through claims made by Brigade Council. In prior years an annual claim was required to be submitted. For 2015 and future years two semi-annual claims are required to be submitted.

The first claim period is January 1 to June 30 and the second claim period is July 1 to December 31.

Any Companies or other Brigade units that paid HST on purchases during 2015 could qualify for the 50% GST / HST rebates. To claim the GST / HST rebates, please submit either copies of paid invoices or a list of paid invoices showing the amount of GST / HST paid on each invoice to Major Dave Ralph, Brigade Council Treasurer.

Claims for the period July 1 to December 31, 2015 must be submitted to Major Ralph by <u>February 15, 2016</u>. Original invoices should be retained for 6 years in case the claims are audited and further support is required.
