All members will need to bring along their own tents this year so it is important that Company Commanders arrange this prior to camp. It is also asked of Company Commanders to confirm tent availability with Lt. Peddle through email so that we can ensure that there are an appropriate number of tents as everyone will be carrying their own gear.

69. Annual Old Comrades' Cribbage & Dart Tournament

This event will be taking place **Saturday, February 6, 2016** at the Old Comrades' Lodge #1, 106 LeMarchant Road, and is open to all members of the CLB over the age of 19.

70. GST / HST Rebate - Change for 2015 and Future Years

The CLB qualifies for a 50% rebate on GST / HST paid on invoices, through claims made by Brigade Council. In prior years an annual claim was required to be submitted. For 2015 and future years two semi-annual claims are required to be submitted. The first claim period is January 1 to June 30 and the second claim period is July 1 to December 31.

Any Companies or other Brigade units that paid HST on purchases during 2015 could qualify for the 50% GST / HST rebates. To claim the GST / HST rebates, please submit either copies of paid invoices or a list of paid invoices showing the amount of GST / HST paid on each invoice to Major Dave Ralph, Brigade Council Treasurer.

Claims for the period July 1 to December 31, 2015 must be submitted to Major Ralph by **February 15, 2016**. Original invoices should be retained for 6 years in case the claims are audited and further support is required.

71. WW1 Pins and Patches

Earlier this year, WW1 Pins, Patches, and Brochures were distributed to all CLB Companies, per Brigade Council Directive 2015-01 issued February 10, 2015. **All** CLB members are entitled to wear these pins or patches until 2018, not just those on your company's strength at the time of the first distribution.

Additional pins or patches are available for **new members only** on a go forward basis. However, since September, there have been very few requests for addition WW1 Patches. Please contact the CLB Quartermaster as new members join your company. You are also

encouraged to please retrieve and reuse, as much as possible, all pins and patches from those members who may leave your company.
