19. Challenge Camp

Challenge Camp will be held on **October 7-9, 2016**. This year's Camp will consist of a hiking expedition on the East Coast Trail in the Southern Shore area. There will be two groups, Novice and Advance, as in previous years. A Camp Application Package was distributed in mid-September. Applications were to be returned to Captain Jamie Peddle by **October 1, 2016**.

Captain Peddle would like to remind everyone that Challenge Camp is quickly approaching and that Application Forms and fees are due. Transportation arrangements will be communicated next week, as soon as numbers are confirmed. He is also seeking more Officers who are willing to take part in the Novice hike as well as a group of Officers who can take part in the base camp support. This year's base camp will have a winter tent and woodstove available for Officer sleeping quarters. 20. Annual Registration Fees

Annual Members Registration Fees for the 2016-2017 Training Year are \$10 per member. Companies are required to remit these fees to Brigade Council by

October 15, 2016. Registration fees are not required for Adult Leaders, but donations in lieu of the fee would be greatly appreciated, and would be acknowledged with official income tax receipts.

21. Anniversary Parade

The 124th Anniversary Parade will be held on **Sunday, October 16, 2016**, to the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist, St. John's. Fall-in will be at the CLB Armoury at 2:00 PM. Following the Service, the parade will return to the CLB Armoury for dismissal at approximately 5:00 PM. *Youth Dress – full uniform with medals. Officers' Dress – full uniform, Sam Browne and medals.* Adult leaders unable to obtain the dress uniform due to unavailability will be permitted to wear the Supplementary Uniform (Blues). Ranks without uniform will not be permitted on parade but may assemble at the Armoury and attend the Service at the Cathedral. Over jackets will not be permitted on parade. If the weather is inclement, the parade will assemble at the Armoury and will be bussed to the Cathedral.

Regimental Colour Officers and Escorts will be provided by Avalon Battalion. Please see list of Parade appointments include with Avalon Battalion Orders below. Battalion Colour Officer and escorts will be provided by the respective Battalions. Colour Officers will bring their own Company Colours.

Members will march with their Companies, with Company Colours marching in front of Companies. Smaller Companies will combine to form a larger unit.

LTC units will report to the Armoury for transportation to and from the Cathedral, arranged by the Regiment. Companies are requested to assign an Adult Leader to travel to the Cathedral with their LTC members, and parents are not permitted to travel to the Cathedral on the bus with the LTC members. YTC units will parade to the Cathedral with their Company as part of the main parade. Following the Service, the LTC and YTC sections will fall in as separate units to watch the parade march off; the LTC section will be transported by bus back to the Armoury, while the YTC section will join the parade and march back to the Armoury.

At the Church, there will be a section reserved up front for LTC members and their Adult Leaders. Throughout the Service, Leaders are asked to keep the youth members' trips to the washroom to a minimum.

Members selected by their Battalion Commanders to do readings at the Service will be contacted by the Assistant Regimental Chaplain.

As in previous years, the Regiment will subsidize 50% of the cost of bussing for out of town Companies.

Also note, that the parade has not been fallen out during the Service, and immediately following the Service, the parade will form up at the Sergeants Memorial with all Officers and Colours on parade ready for the March Past.
