

Instructions for Nominators to complete the Nomination Package:

1. Identify a nominee for the C.L.B. Award. Note that the nomination process must remain confidential to the greatest extent possible, i.e., the nominee should not know that he or she is being nominated for a C.L.B. Award.
2. Brigade Council must receive the completed Nomination Form between January 1st and September 30th each year, in its entirety, including a 100-300 word citation to be completed in the space provided. All nominations will be held indefinitely.
3. When the nomination package is complete, e-mail or mail to the Governor and Commandant, CLB Armoury, 82 Harvey Road, St. John's, NL, A1C 2G1, clb@nf.aibn.com and include your name, rank and contact information.
4. Brigade Council will announce Awards annually at the Anniversary Parade in October.

The **Award of Merit** is given for extraordinary efforts towards strengthening of the Brigade. The award is limited to six (6) at any one time and when vacancies occur. The award does not necessarily have to be made to keep the numbers up to that figure.

The **Brigade Cross** is awarded for a combination of outstanding service to the Brigade, while also witnessing an extension of the Brigade Motto, Christian responsibility and public service. This award must be seen as a demonstration to other Brigade members of an example of Christian extension and community involvement, but only on a volunteer basis.

The **Exemplary Service Medal** is awarded to any adult member, with a recommended minimum of 10 years service. This award must demonstrate exemplary service to the Brigade through service and commitment to duty. Action should clearly show consistent service over and beyond the call of duty. The service may be carried out in one specific area or in a number of areas of Brigade activities.

The **Fortitude Medal** is awarded in recognition of tenacity and personal courage in adversity. This award must be seen as a demonstration to other Brigade members of devotion to service on behalf of the Brigade; or service to the Church and community may be considered in addition to regular Brigade duties. Examples of tenacity and courage may be as a result of a lifetime handicap of some sort or, may be as a result of some sickness or illness to the candidate.

The **Gallant Conduct Medal (Gold)** is awarded to a member who, conscious of grave risk to personal life, makes a deliberate and courageous attempt to preserve the life of another.

The **Gallant Conduct Medal (Silver)** is awarded to a member who, with presence of mind, makes a prompt and plucky attempt to preserve the life of another.

Honourary Membership in the Brigade may be conferred on persons who have made an extraordinary contribution to the CLB and are not members of the Brigade.
