83. Mint Brook Campsite

Having been presented with a substantial capital requirement for remediation and repairs to bring the campsite up to required standards, the Central Diocese have decided to **discontinue its operation of the Mint Brook Camp and Conference Centre**, and plan to offer the property for sale on the commercial market. For many of us, this represents the end of an era, as the CLB has camped at Mint Brook for the past 50 years since 1967. The CLB, however, will be given first opportunity to retrieve all our equipment and belongings at Mint Brook prior to the disposal of the campsite.

Regimental Staff have since met with the Eastern Diocese, and the Lavrock Camp and Conference Centre is available for our use in July. A 5-day Summer Camp for SC and JTC will be held July 1-5. This will be followed by a 2-day overnight expedition for SC members only July 6-7. Both SC and JTC Camps will operate simultaneously, but with totally separate SC and JTC programs as in the past. A joint meeting of camp staffs from recent years will be held in the near future to discuss details and logistics for this year's camps. Date for this meeting will be announced as soon as it becomes available.

Claims for the period July 1 to December 31, 2016 must be submitted to Major Ralph by **February 15, 2017**. Original invoices should be retained for 6 years in case the claims are audited and further support is required.
