Gallant Conduct Medal (Silver)

The Gallant Conduct Medal (Silver) is awarded to a member who, with presence of mind, makes a prompt and plucky attempt to preserve the life of another.

On Tuesday, September 12th this year, Nathalie Vanasse, a Science Technician, was at work in the Chemistry Building of MUN. She was made aware that someone was in grave need of first aid in the hallway near her workplace. After working her way through a crowd that had gathered, and armed with the office first aid kit, Nathalie discovered that a co-worker had collapsed near the elevator and appeared to be in critical condition, with no pulse, not breathing and poor complexion. She immediately took charge of the scene, began administering CPR while sending another co-worker to retrieve the AED and call 911. They shocked the victim twice with the defibrillator but failed to restart the heart. She continued with CPR until the EMTs arrived and then continued with chest compressions under their instruction while they worked. Once moved to the ambulance, the EMT's were able to revive the individual; however, two days later, her co-worker sadly passed away in hospital. Though the outcome was heart-breaking, Nathalie's training, determination and heroic efforts gave her co-worker and friend a fighting chance.
